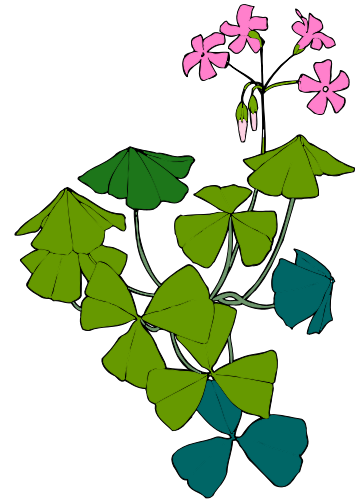


Majestic View Ministry
